MEMORANDUM FOR United States Army, Promotion Work Centers (PWCs)

SUBJECT: Department of the Army (DA) Promotion Point Cutoff Scores for 1 September 2016 and Junior Enlisted Issues for the Active Army (AA)

1. **References:** Army Regulation (AR) 600-8-19, Enlisted Promotions and Reductions - Published on 18 December 2015, effective date of 1 January 2016.

2. **Work Analysis and Integration.**

- a. **Purpose:** To reinforce current procedures concerning the above subject.
- b. **Function:** Enlisted Promotions and Reductions.
- c. **Task:** Process monthly DA promotion point cutoff scores and enlisted promotion issues.

3. Eligible Soldiers who meet the following criteria may appear before a promotion board between 20 July 2016 through 4 August 2016 as follows:

- a. To Staff Sergeant (SSG) must complete Structured Self Development (SSD) 2 prior to board appearance. In accordance with (IAW) AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-28 a (3).
- b. To SSG **primary** zone: Sergeant (SGT) with minimum 71 months time in service (TIS) and 9 months time in grade (TIG).
- c. To SSG **secondary** zone: SGT with minimum 47 months TIS and 6 months TIG.
- d. To SGT must complete SSD 1 prior to board appearance, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-28 a. (1).
- e. To SGT **primary** zone: Corporal (CPL) /Specialist (SPC) with minimum 35 months TIS and 7 months TIG.
- f. To SGT **secondary** zone: CPL/SPC with minimum 17 months TIS and 5 months TIG.
- g. Soldiers must meet all eligibility criteria IAW AR 600-8-19, Table 3-1.

4. Soldiers who are otherwise eligible and held recommended list status as of 20 July 2016 through 8 August 2016 and who meet or exceed the cutoff score as they appear beginning on page 4, and the criteria listed below, may be promoted effective 1 September 2016 as follows:

- a. To SSG must graduate the Advanced Leader Course (ALC) before they are eligible for consideration for promotion pin-on to SSG, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-28 a (4).
- b. To SSG **primary** zone: SGT with 72 months TIS and 10 months TIG.
- c. To SSG **secondary** zone: SGT with minimum 48 TIS and 7 months TIG.

d. To SGT must graduate the Basic Leader Course (BLC) before they are eligible for consideration for promotion pin-on to SGT, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1-28 a (2).

e. To SGT **primary** zone: CPL/SPC with 36 months TIS and 8 months TIG.

f. To SGT **secondary** zone: CPL/SPC with 18 months TIS and 6 months TIG.

g. Soldiers must meet all eligibility criteria IAW AR 600-8-19, Table 3-3.

5. **SPC Waiver Information:** The Directorate of Military Personnel Management (DMPM), Army G1 has announced the variable specialist waiver ceiling percentage is 17%, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 2-5h.

REMINDERS/GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. **Promotion Point Worksheet (PPW) Training, Assessment and Access** – As a reminder, the cutoff for users to complete PPW certification was last Friday 19 Aug 16. If promotions NCOs/Clerks have not completed the training please do so. It will take HRC about a week to process the remaining PPW requests for access that were turned in by 19 Aug 16. On or about Monday 29 Aug 16, we will suspend access to all users on our old tracking roster that have not successfully completed the PPW certification.

If you are having issues or need any additional assistance send in an email or call us at 502-613-9013. It is very important that units have certified PPW Users. Soldiers will have to be integrated onto the PPW by the 8th of September to be considered for October Promotions and Soldiers will not be able to be integrated if units do not have access. Remember, failure to integrate does not meet the requirements for an Administrative Records Correction (ARC) unless it is a system failure. Simply not integrating them due to lack of user qualification is not a system failure.

2. **Select – Train – Educate - Promote (STEP)** - Visit our HRC Enlisted STEP web page by clicking [here](#).

Soldiers who are not fully qualified for promotion will not be selected for promotion pin-on regardless of the promotion point scores.

3. **New AR 600-8-19**, Enlisted Promotions and Reductions - Published on 18 December 2015 with an effective date of 1 January 2016. To obtain a copy go to <http://www.apd.army.mil/>.

4. **No Cutoff Scores** - Soldiers in Primary Military Occupational Specialty 18B, 18C, 18D, 18E, and 38B are promoted IAW Milper Message 16-067 provided otherwise qualified IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 1–10 without meeting a cutoff score. No cutoff scores will be published.

5. **Service remaining requirement (SRR)** - If a promotable Soldier in the rank of SGT is listed on the DA By-Name List and does not meet the SRR within 30 days (RA) and 60 days (USAR) from the promotion effective date, they should be removed from the promotion recommended list (PRL). IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraphs 1-10 a (5), 3-27 c (3), and 3-32 a (3).

6. **As a reminder**, IAW AR 600-8-19, paragraph 3-23 b, all Soldiers denied list integration will be counseled, in writing, IAW the provisions of paragraph 1–27 and the unit CDR must initiate a bar to reenlistment IAW AR 601–280. For more information read all of paragraph 3-23.

7. Units throughout the Army are updating Soldiers training records in Electronic Military Personnel Office (eMILPO) to reflect completion of military resident courses using online training course certificates as the supporting documents. As a result, Soldiers are receiving erroneous promotion points. This issue affects Soldiers getting promoted to SGT and SSG. To receive promotion points for resident military training the courses must be formally listed in Army Training Requirements and Resources System (ATRRS) and in the Soldier's ATRRS records. BDE/BN S1s and Military Personnel Division (MPD) personnel must verify that Soldiers attended the resident course by reviewing their ATRRS transcript prior to submitting updates into eMILPO. Any promotion obtained with erroneous documentation will result in an administrative reduction.

8. After Soldiers appear on the DA Promotion Selection/By-Name List, unit's are required to ensure that Soldiers (SPC/SGT) have a current record Army Physical Fitness Test on the promotion effective date (The date the Soldier met the cutoff score is not the effective date of the promotion), is not flagged, not barred from reenlistment, graduates of BLC for promotion to SGT, ALC and meets SRR for promotion to SSG.

9. **Invalid promotion boards** - Promotion boards must be conducted between the 20th of the month preceding the board month and no later than the 4th day of the board month. A First Sergeant (E8 or below) as the board president or promotion boards conducted outside of the dates stated will make promotion boards invalid. The Junior Enlisted Promotions section will flag all Soldiers appearing on the promotion board proceedings. See AR 600-8-19, paragraph 3-12 d, composition of promotion boards.

10. **Milper Messages** – Unit S1 and MPD personnel and Soldiers should review the following messages: 13-212, 13-289, 13-340, 14-022, 14-196, 14-358, 15-022, 15-264, 16-067, 16-156 and 16-186.
